This winner, at 2 years old, across the Channel, is none other than the uterine sister, by the «top-flyer» and leading stallion **Dutch Art**, of the champion **Channel**, winner of the Prix de Diane (Group I) and best filly of her promotion, in France, in 2019. **Magical Romance**, their grandmother, won the Cheveley Park Stakes (Group 1), at 2, and is the three-quarter sister of **Alexandrova**, international star, triple victorious at the highest level, in the Oaks, Irish Oaks and Yorkshire Oaks. A pedigree, quite simply, exceptional.
